

Wild Oxfordshire Cookie Policy - January 2018

Cookies

Cookies are used to enable us to improve services for you through, for example:

- remembering if you are logged in so you can move around the website without having to log in again on each page (for example if you are in checkout)
- measuring how many people are using each page of the website and for how long so that we can try to improve the quality of our website
- enabling you to view content shared on other sites e.g. YouTube or Twitter

How to control and delete cookies

How do I disable cookies?

If you want to disable cookies you need to change your website browser settings to reject cookies. How to do this will depend on the browser you use - you will need to access your 'privacy' or 'preferences' settings via a 'tools' or 'files' menu.

What happens if I disable cookies?

This depends on which cookies you disable, but in general the site may not operate properly if cookies are switched off.

For information on how to do this on the browser of your mobile phone you will need to refer to your handset manual. Restricting cookies may impact on the functionality of the website.

Cookies help us deliver personalised content to you and provide anonymous reports to us on how visitors use our site. At the moment we only use Google Analytics.

Google Analytics

The website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics sets a cookie in order to evaluate your use of the website and compile reports for us on activity on the site.

Google stores the information collected by the cookie on servers in the United States of America. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. By using Wild Oxfordshire's website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above.
